New 'Do, New You!

Dark roots are maintained and seamlessly blended into hair's new taupe, ash-blond hue. Tons of layers are styled to breathe life into the look and barely any length is removed. Hair is smoothed to wrap around the face and really highlight the intricate depth of color that was created.

STYLE TIP! For that beautiful, lived-in appearance to your mane, try flipping hair over and spraying your favorite dry shampoo or hairspray throughout. You can also rub a bit of style paste into thinner locks.



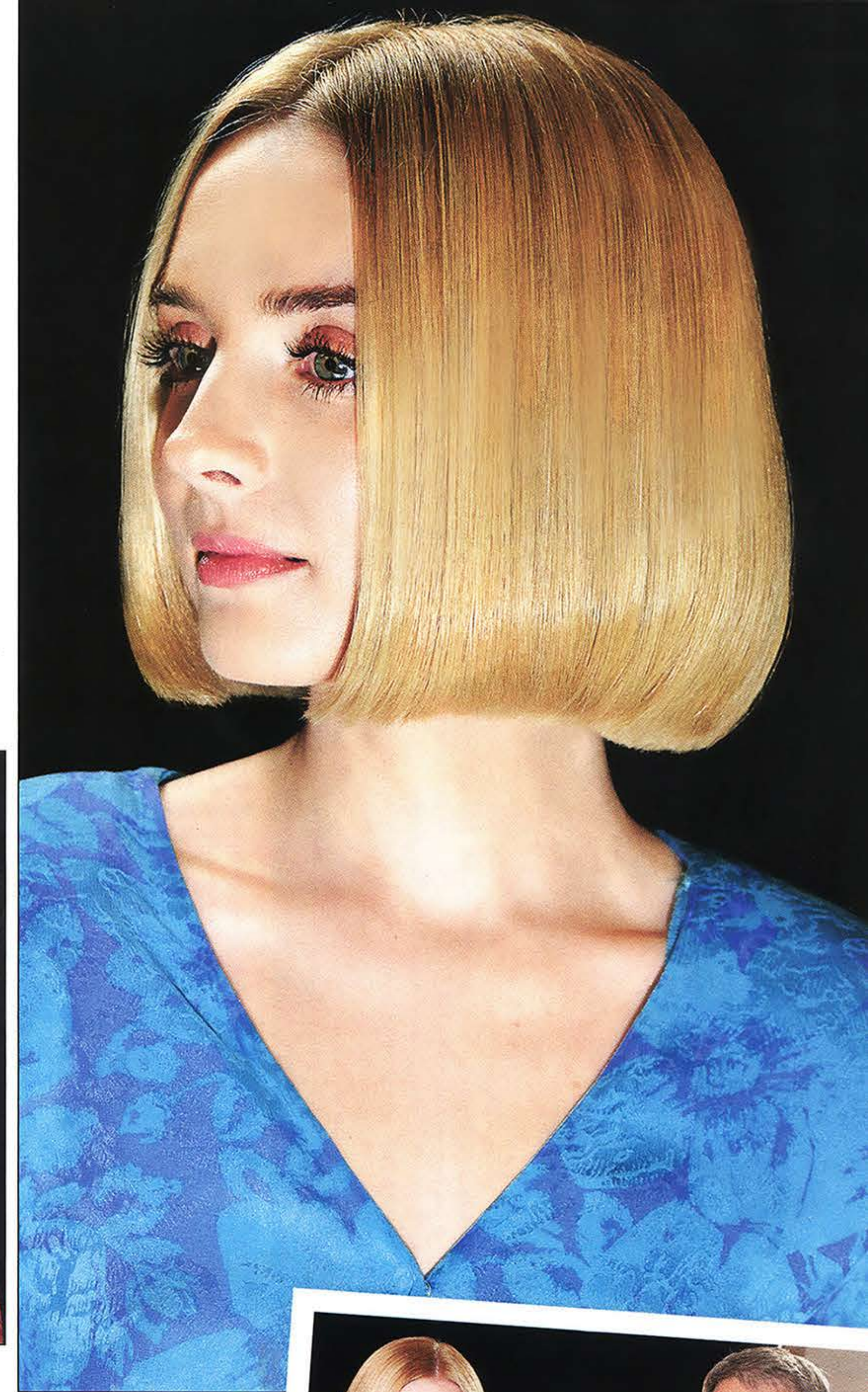

Who's That Girl?

An even, blunt cut is styled onto this bob. Warm, honey-blond hair falls from a defined middle part in a perfectly smooth texture, curving around the jawline on the ends. This hairstyle is bold, feisty and perfectly on-trend.

STYLE TIP! For super shiny and sleek styles it wouldn't hurt to apply a shine serum to damp hair, blow-dry with a flat brush and then smooth with your flat iron. Use a toothbrush and hairspray to get any flyaways into line if needed.

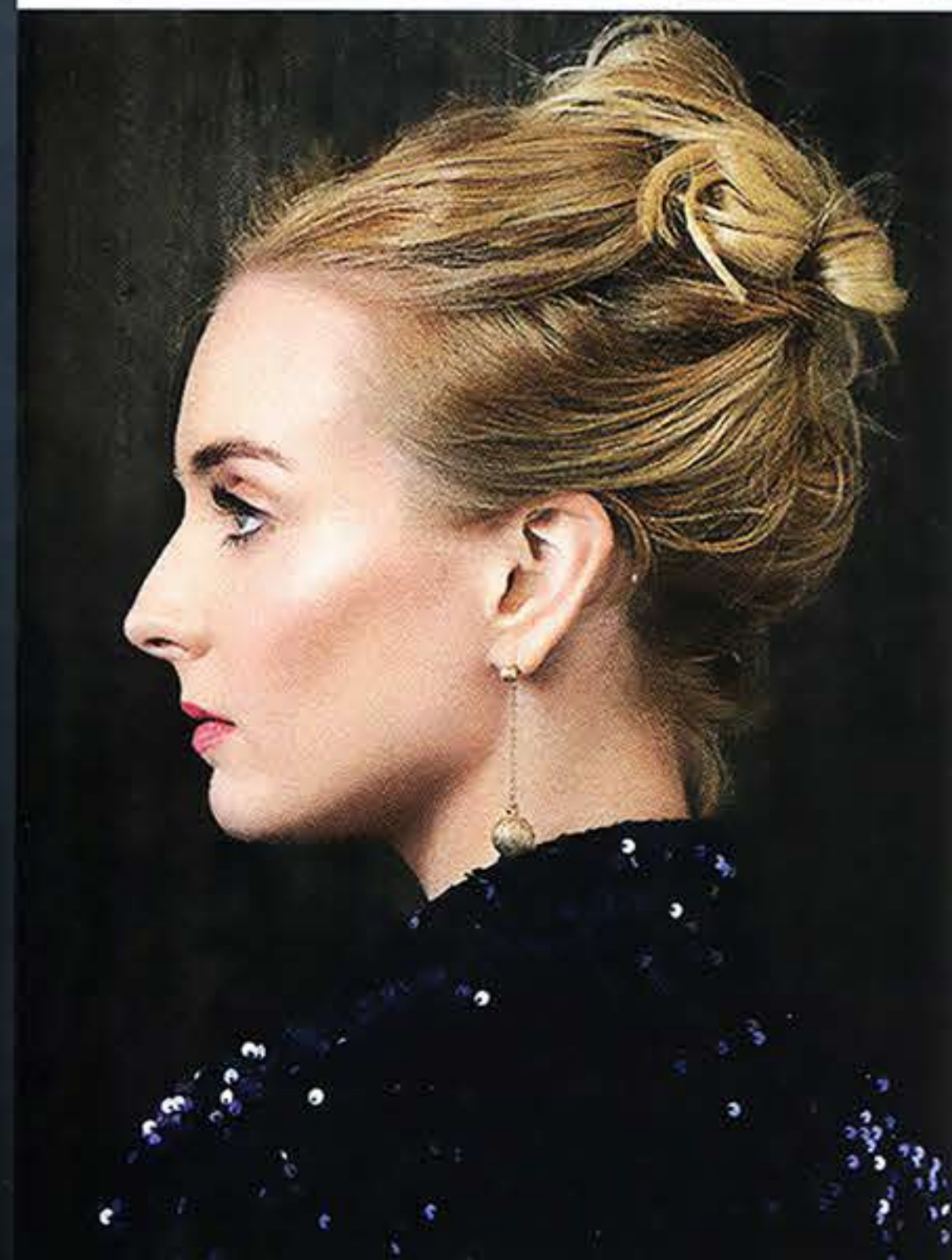


Stylist Uwe Keller of Uwe Keller Salon tucks in a few last strands to perfect this gorgeous upsweep.



Options

This upsweep is just too bewitching not to admire. The sides and back are pulled to the center and tucked into a messy chignon-inspired silhouette that's adorned with a hair comb. Tresses in the front and crown are brushed straight back for added sass to this look's profile.

► Change-up your texture with bouncy curls (top left)! Strands are curled into defined, large spirals that create a completely new shape and vibe to this short cut. Opt for a curling iron over a wand for more stylized curls.

► Let's give this updo a round of applause (bottom left)! Strands are sectioned off, and then each portion is twisted, tucked and secured at the base of the crown. This technique is great for shorter manes and looks perfectly imperfect.
